he project for Preparedness for Oil-polluted Shoreline Cleanup and Oiled Wildlife interventions – POSOW is a two year project funded by the European Commission under the Civil Protection Financial Instrument, to improve the preparedness and response to marine pollution in the Mediterranean region. The project aims at establishing a regional cooperation synergy through the enhancement of knowledge and capacities of operators (professionals and volunteers) in the field of marine pollution, in European coastal countries of the Mediterranean Sea namely Croatia, Cyprus, France, Greece, Italy, Malta, Slovenia and Spain.

POSOW Training Packages completed in May 2013

The POSOW team is pleased to announce that the training packages on Oiled Shoreline Assessment and Cleanup, Oil Spill Volunteer Management and Oiled Wildlife Response, to be used during trainings, and to ensure wide knowledge dissemination of information gathered during the project, are now available on POSOW website. The training packages consist of:

- 4 manuals providing detailed guidance and information;
- 11 posters designed to be used in the field, summarizing and illustrating key messages to be considered by response operators (professionals or volunteers) when responding to an oil spill;
- 15 Power-Point Presentations to facilitate the delivery of training courses at national level;
- 7 languages: <u>Posters</u> and <u>Power-Point presentations</u> (upcoming) translated into Croatian, English, Greek, French, Italian, Slovenian and Spanish to facilitate the understanding of the local trainers.





Train the Trainer Course in Brest

Participants from Croatia, Cyprus, Greece, Italy and Slovenia, attended the first Train the Trainer Courses of the POSOW Project, held between the 21 and 23 May 2013. The second training was held between the 28 and 30 May 2013. Participants from Greece, France, Malta, and Spain attended the Course.

Theoretical and practical exercises were organised to allow the future trainers to replicate the trainings in their respective regions, during the second part of the year 2013.

Facilities and equipment from Cedre were used to practice the shoreline assessment and cleanup techniques.
