The POSOW Oiled Shoreline Assessment Manual is now available!

The Oiled Shoreline Assessment Manual, developed under the POSOW Project is now available for download. The manual has been prepared by *Cedre* in collaboration with all project partners. This document is designed to help teams of volunteers to understand and be able to undertake shoreline surveys to provide key information for authorities during the first or 'reactive' phase of the response.



This manual is one of 4 manuals produced in the framework of the POSOW project. The others address the Oil Spill Volunteer Management, Oiled Shoreline Cleanup and Oiled Wildlife Response, and will be available early 2013. The manual can be downloaded from the Manual Section in Documentation.

Promotion of POSOW in various events

In the last three months, POSOW project has been introduced during several events. First in Cyprus during 2 events organised by the district of Larnaca under the auspices of Cyprus EU Presidency and in cooperation with MAREMED EU Project and CPMR: seminar on maritime safety, 9 October 2012, and shoreline cleanup training course, 10-11 October.

The Project was also introduced at the Maritime Safety Conference "10 years on from the sinking of the prestige", organised by Surfrider Foundation, held in Biarritz (France) from 22 to 23 November 2012. At last, POSOW was also presented on 30 November during the "Knowledge sharing and Communication seminar" organised by the ITAC (Industry Technical Advisory Committee) in Southampton. Manual Tested

The POSOW oiled shoreline assessment manual has been used during two training courses held in Normandy (France). During these courses, 40 participants coming from local authorities have been trained to fill the "oiled shoreline assessment form" and to use other tools available in the manual.

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
