

The project for

Preparedness for Oil-polluted Shoreline cleanup and Oiled Wildlife interventions (POSOW)

is co-funded by the European Union under the Union Civil Protection Mechanism, to improve the preparedness and response to marine pollution in the Mediterranean region.

POSOW II (2015 - 2016) is a follow-up to the project POSOW I (2012 - 2013). The main aim remains to reinforce the knowledge and skills of volunteers working in civil protection services, in municipalities and in NGOs and involved in spill response. After targeting 8 European Union coastal countries in POSOW I (namely Croatia, Cyprus, France, Greece, Italy, Malta, Slovenia and Spain), POSOW II targets 7 Southern Mediterranean European Neighborhood Policy Countries and Enlargement Countries namely: Algeria, Egypt, Lebanon, Libya, Morocco, Tunisia and Turkey.


