**TOUTSORB – MSDS**

FIRST AID:

- Eye contact: flush eyes with water.  
Seek medical attention if necessary
- Skin contact: remove with soap and water
- Inhalation: remove to fresh air.  
If needed, seek medical help
- Ingestion: under normal conditions, material is non-toxic

PPE

- ✓ Goggles: when spraying the product.
- ✓ Gloves: normally not required
- ✓ Paper mask: when spraying the product.
